



2025 Corporate Fast



Isaiah 58:6-7, NKJV

6 "Is this not the fast that I have chosen: To loose the bonds of wickedness, To undo the heavy burdens, To let the oppressed go free, And that you break every yoke? 7 Is it not to share your bread with the hungry, And that you bring to your house the poor who are cast out; When you see the naked, that you cover him, And not hide yourself from your own flesh?"

Our 2025 Fast will begin Monday, January 6th and end Friday, January 10th. We are asking as many as will to join in with us in this consecration time as we believe God for continual direction and insight according to His divine will. During this fast we ask that you seek God as to how He would have you to consecrate yourself. Let's believe God in what He has said for 2025; ***"Being About The Business!"***

"And He said to them, "Why did you seek Me? Did you not know that I must be about My Father's business?" (Luke 2:49, NKJV)

PURPOSE OF THIS FAST

- We believe that God is calling for a conscience and concentrated return and commitment to prayer and intercession for His Church and the world around us. (I Thessalonians 5:17)
- We believe that 2024 had a designed purpose by God that has positioned us for His plan to be perfected in 2025. We declare a healthy and blessed Church equipped with a fresh anointing for ministry. (Jeremiah 29:11, NIV)
- We believe that during the fast God will release a fresh passion for soul winning (evangelism) in house and outside the house. We will have a heart for souls not just to come in but be raised up, equipped and retained. (Matthew 28:18-20)
- We believe that God is raising up "Sower's" who are financially stable and responsible. They will see to it that Kingdom agendas are advanced and that there is no lack in God's House. (II Corinthians 9:10)
- We believe that this fast shall cause sons and daughters to rise and serve in God's Vineyard. We will declare that the laborers are here! (Luke 10:2)

- We declare this fast to bring forth divine healing for the sick (physically and mentally). All past, present and future illnesses and diagnoses are covered under the blood! (I Peter 2:24)
- We declare this fast to be a total dismantling of all illegal ties, covenants and agreements. Freedom and expression will come forth as the chains of the past are broken. This will be a year of restoration and recovery. (Isaiah 61:1, Luke 4:18)

TYPES OF FASTS

Complete Fast

- Drinking only liquids, typically water and/or light juices. Broth or soup may be included as options.

Partial Fast

- Removing certain items from your daily diet.
- The Daniel Fast - abstaining from meat, sweets, or bread; drink water and juice, and eat a variety of fruits and vegetables.
 - This can be done in the morning and/or afternoon.
- Fast during specific times of the day, e.g., 6AM-3PM, or from sunup to sundown.
- Anoint yourself with oil and pray over yourself daily as you consecrate before God.

STRATEGY FOR A SUCCESSFUL FAST

- To fast and pray that there will be a true sense of humility and honor for God and His purposes.

“If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land” (II Chronicles 7:14).

- To believe that God is a God of faith and not slack concerning His promises. What we believe for shall come to pass.

“But without faith *it is impossible to please Him*, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and *that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him*” (Hebrews 11:6, NKJV).

- To seek for the peace of God for Israel and the world around us.

6 Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: "May they prosper who love you. 7 Peace be within your walls, Prosperity within your palaces." (Psalm 122:6-7, NKJV).

- To believe God and pray for righteousness and holiness to prevail in our government as there is a changing of the guards.

1 Therefore I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men, 2 for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence. 3 For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, 4 who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth. (I Timothy 2:1-4, NKJV)

- To pray for a great outpour of Holy Spirit.

"And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams" (Acts 2:17).

- To stand in agreement in unity and support for one another as the Body of Christ locally, nationally and internationally.

2 fulfill my joy by being like-minded, having the same love, *being* of one accord, of one mind. 3 *Let nothing be done* through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. 4 Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others. (Philippians 2:2-4, NKJV)

FOCUS FOR THE FAST

In our time of prayer and consecration, be purposeful in praying for your pastor's, leaders and the Body of Christ as a whole. A healthy church makes for a healthy land.

Pray specifically for the success of all ministries, budgets, plans, services, outings, fellowships, social media platforms, partners, those connected, and all other functions associated with the church.

Pray that all of us live out these words:

"Love God, Love All People And Do Everything In Love!"

"We Are Blessed, Prosperous, Healthy And Wealthy, And All The Blessings Of Deuteronomy 28 Are Ours In Jesus Name!"

Corporate prayer times during the fast will be 5:00am, 12:00pm and 6:00pm daily at the church.
