“Your Big Three!”

II Timothy 1:7, NKJV (emphasis added)

“For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.”

- I. Your Big Three begins with power. The Greek word is dunamis and it is the first part of God’s deposit inside of you. You access it through Holy Spirit. What this word means is that you have:**
 - A. Supernatural strength**
 - B. Explosive ability**

- II. The second deposit is the greatest working force in all the earth – love. The familiar Greek word is agapé. The same love that the Father showed his Son is the same love at work on the inside of you. This love is:**
